





SANFORD PROMISE SCHOLARS

High school students with an aptitude for biomedical sciences may apply for our unique 10-week research internship which offers a total-immersion experience in real-time laboratory research. Work alongside scientists as part of a research team and connect with peers through in-house scientific interest groups.

PROMISE Scholars earn three undergraduate elective credits at the University of South Dakota (BIOC192) and are awarded a scholarship.

PARTICIPANTS WILL:

- Gain exposure to real-world research
- Cultivate research proficiency
- Create a scientific poster to present at a regional scientific symposium
- Discover the process of conducting a scholarly article review
- Learn the importance of scientific ethical principles
- Enhance communication abilities
- Access career coaching seminars
- Investigate post-secondary opportunities

Candidates are encouraged to participate in other Sanford PROMISE programs as an introduction to the research environment.

- Motivated high school students should have a strong interest in a scientific career
- Applications are available October 1 and must be submitted by January 10

- Students from underrepresented backgrounds and historically marginalized or excluded groups are strongly encouraged to apply
